Synaxis of All Saints of America: On the second Sunday after Pentecost, each local Orthodox Church commemorates all the saints, known and unknown, who have shone forth in its territory. Accordingly, the Orthodox Church in America remembers the saints of North America on this day. They include Alexander Hotovitzky, Alexis of Wilkes-Barre, Anatole (Kamensky) of Irkutsk, Barnabas (Nastić) of Hvosno, Herman of Alaska, Innocent of Alaska, Jacob Netsvetov, John (Maximovitch) the Wonderworker, John Kochurov, Juvenaly of Alaska, Mardarije (Uskoković) of America, Nicholas (Velimirović) of Žiča, Peter the Aleut, Raphael of Brooklyn, Sebastian (Dabovich), Tikhon of Moscow, and Vasily Martysz. In addition to the saints listed above, we also honor those saints who are known only to God, and have not been recognized officially by the Church. As we contemplate the lives of these saints, let us remember that we are also called by God to a life of holiness.
